



# **TRAVEL TO CHINA THIS WINTER BREAK!**

*FUNDING AVAILABLE!*

Interested in spending two weeks in beautiful Hangzhou, China, this winter break?

The **Department of Asian Studies** and the **China & Asia-Pacific Studies Program (CAPS)** will administer a special package being offered by the Chinese government to Cornell students. The package provides 50% of airfare from New York City (or perhaps another major city) to Hangzhou, as well as all room and board, and tuition for a special two-week session that includes Chinese language instruction, local tours, and cultural activities. All Cornell undergraduate students are welcome to apply, but priority will be given to Asian Studies and CAPS majors and minors. Additionally, some packages may be available to graduate students whose work is related to China.

Up to 50 funding packages may be offered.

Complete the attached application and submit it to the Asian Studies office (Rockefeller 350) by Monday, **November 16<sup>th</sup>**; successful applicants will be announced within a few days. Details of air travel and other arrangements will be forthcoming.

Cornell offers no credit for the brief classes provided during this program. The Chinese government does not allow these scholarships to be awarded to Chinese nationals.
